1. Getting our statute changed to allow biennial renewal. This new law also grants us the authority to set our renewal deadline and fee via administrative rule – meaning the Board does not have to go to the legislature to change renewal fees or dates. No fee increase is planned.
2. The Board granted Board-approved chiropractic education institution to D'Youville College's Chiropractic Program.

WHAT IS THE MOST PRESSING CONCERN YOU HAVE?

Budget restrictions – the Board's budget was significantly reduced by the legislature this year, causing us to give up our dedicated licensure coordinator position.

Travel restrictions prevent the Board from participating in out of state meetings and educational opportunities.

Biennial Renewal – the Board will renew biennially for the first time on April 1, 2010. This new law will necessitate changing our continuing education rules. A complete overhaul of our CE requirements is planned.
